Okularfest, a seven-hour symposium covering advances in diagnosis and treatment of anterior and posterior segment diseases, is coming to Southern California on October 7, 2012. This one-day event, created by the doctors of the Retina Eye Institute of California (RIC), is expected to be the largest Continuing Education (CE) forum to be offered in California to date.
